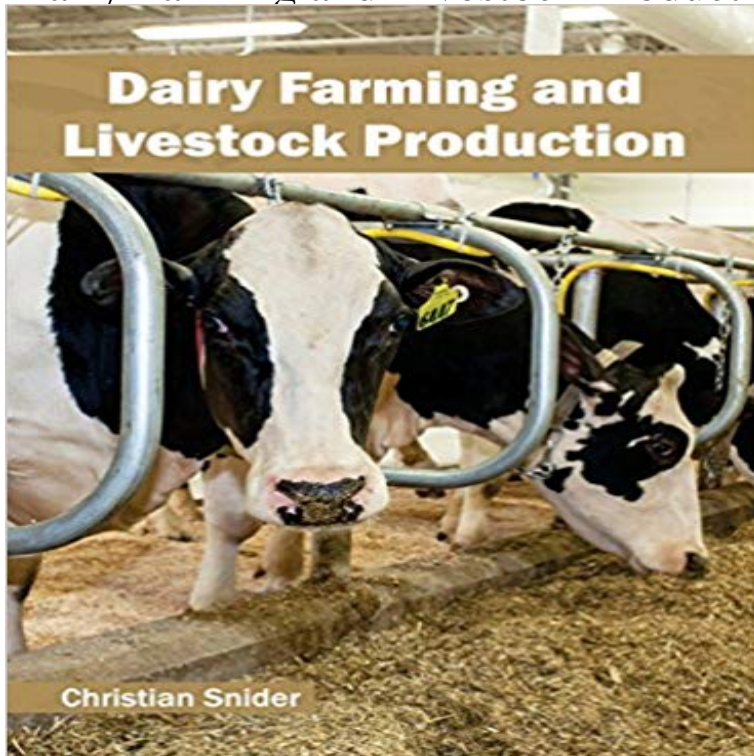


Dairy Farming and Livestock Production
