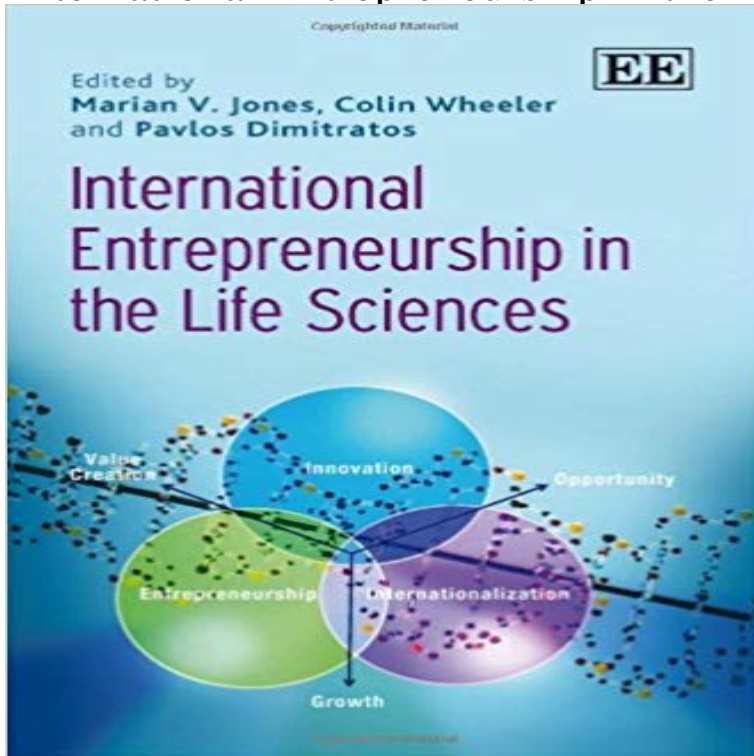


International Entrepreneurship in the Life Sciences
