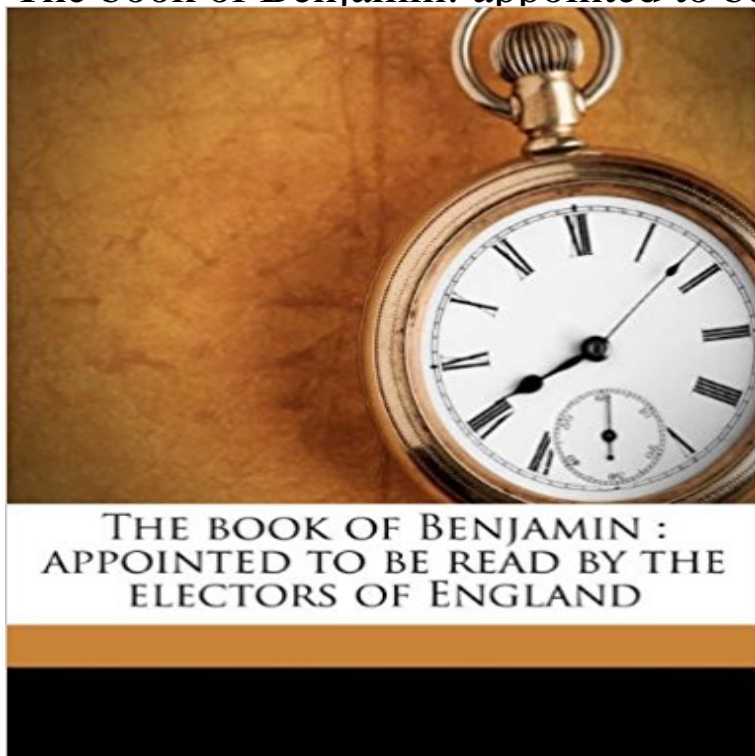


The book of Benjamin: appointed to be read by the electors of England
