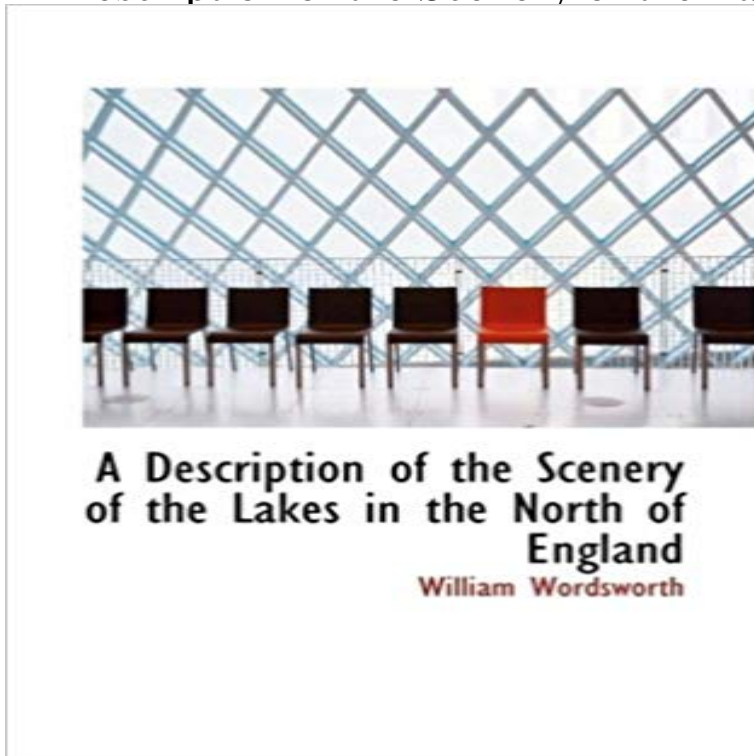


A Description of the Scenery of the Lakes in the North of England
