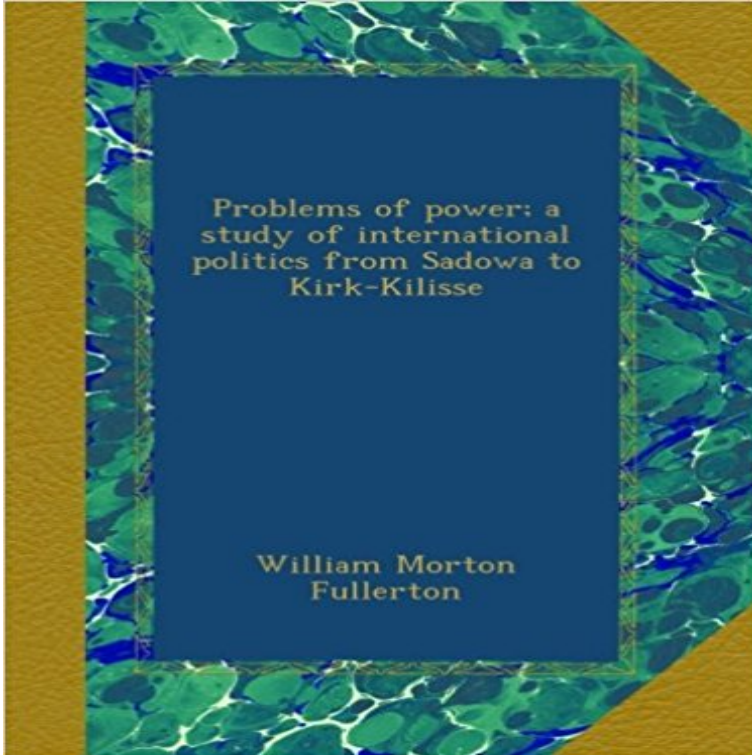


# Problems of power; a study of international politics from Sadowa to Kirk-Kilisse
