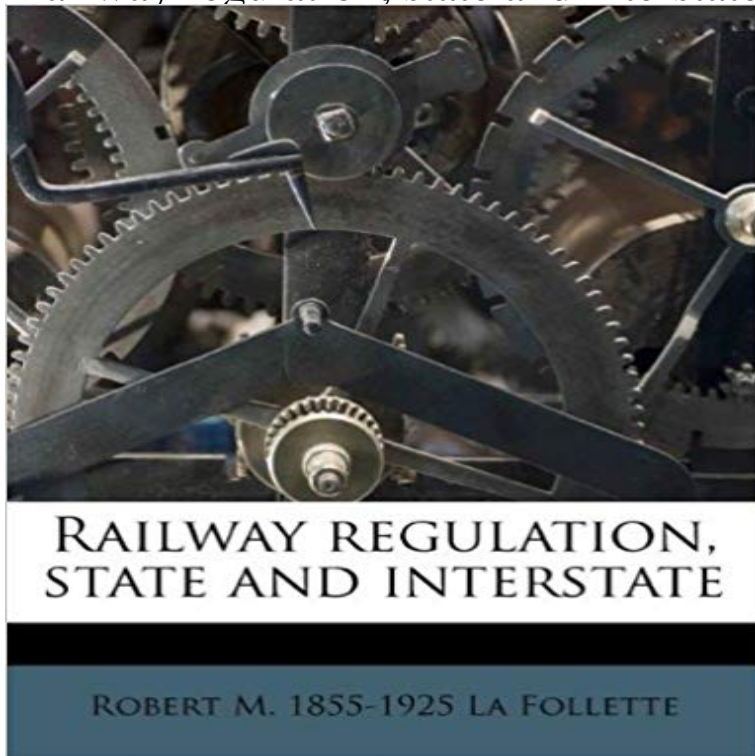


## Railway regulation, state and interstate
