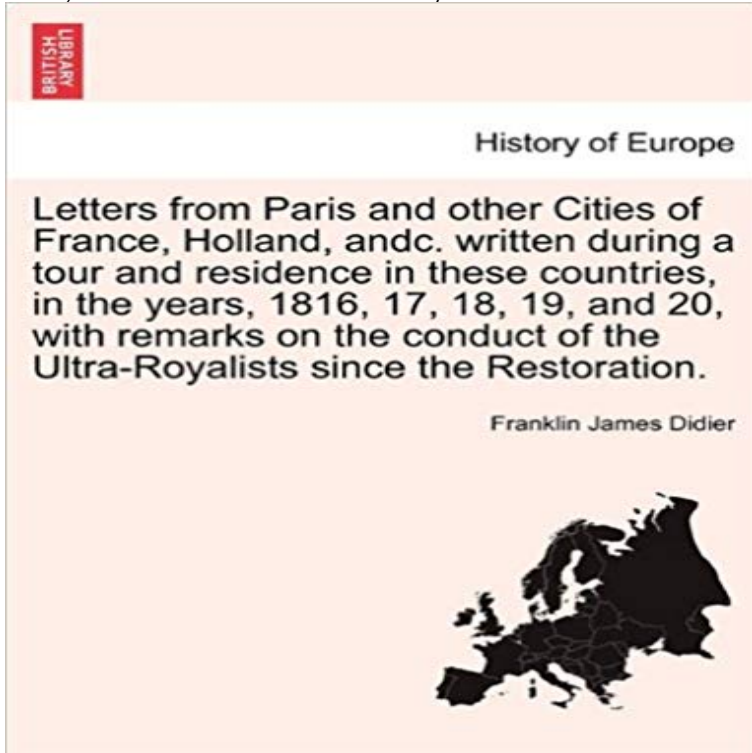

Written** During the Restoration of the Bourbon monarchy (18151830) that followed the downfall of Napoleon, Paris was ruled by a royal government which tried to reverse many of the changes made to the city during the French Revolution. The city grew in population from 713,9 to 785,866 in 1831. The Russians moved into the barracks of the French Army around the city. **Letters from Paris and other cities of France, Holland, & c : written** The Directory was a five-member committee which governed France from 1795, when it replaced the Committee of Public Safety, until it was overthrown by Napoleon Bonaparte in the Coup of 18 Brumaire (89 November 1799) and replaced by the French Consulate. in 1799, after several defeats, French victories in the Netherlands and
