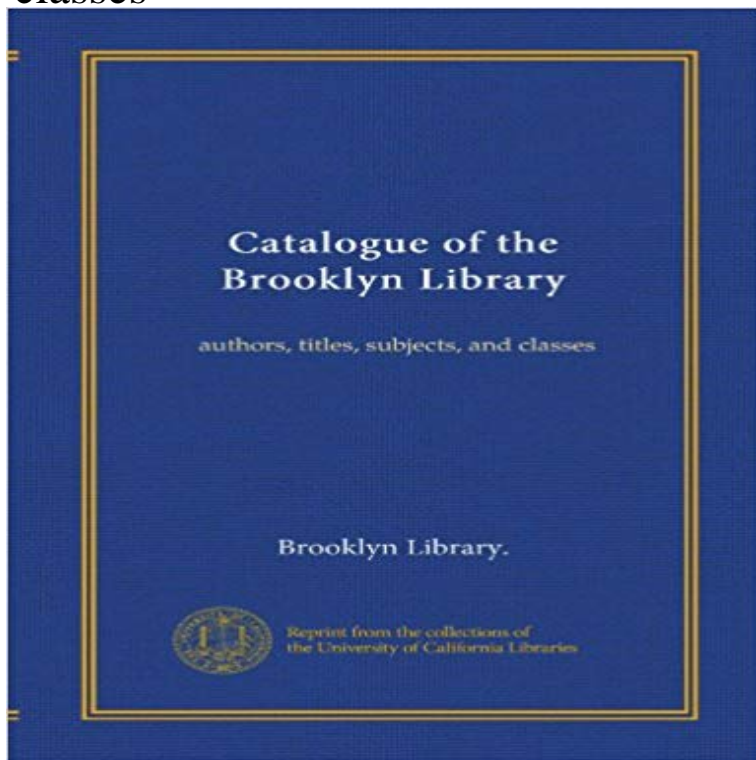


# Catalogue of the Brooklyn Library (v.1): authors, titles, subjects, and classes
