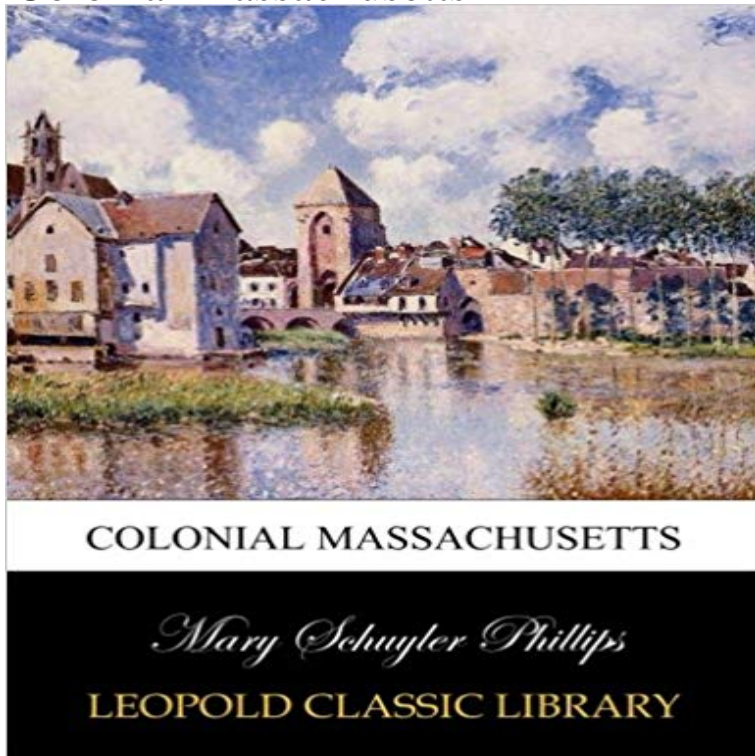


## Colonial Massachusetts
