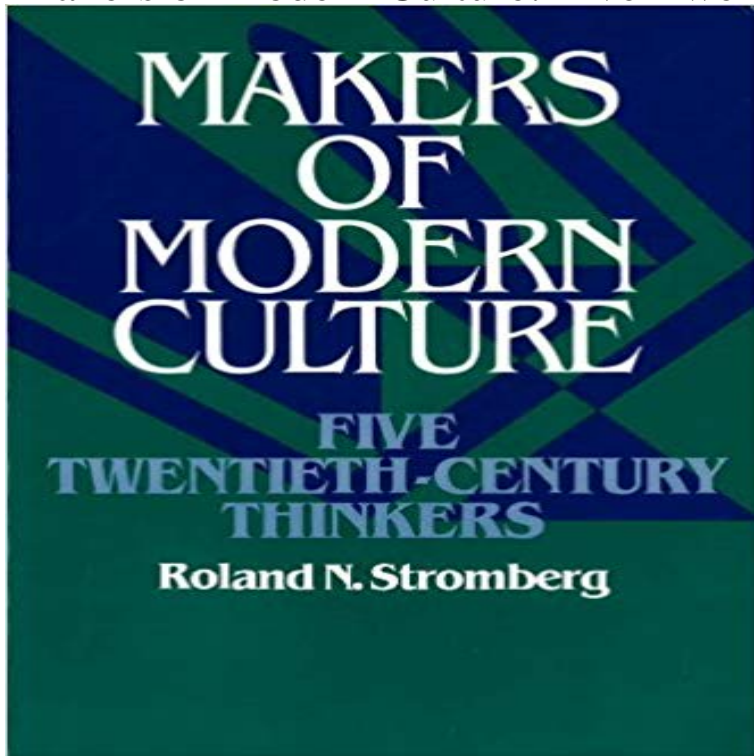


Makers of Modern Culture: Five Twentieth-Century Thinkers

This book provides an introduction to five figures who contributed significantly to the attitudes, culture, and philosophies of our century, portraying these men as they were - brilliant, imaginative, and sometimes enigmatic, but always fascinating. A concluding essay discusses their importance for our times. Finally, a bibliographical essay is provided for students who wish to consult significant primary and secondary sources about these intellectuals.
