

# Archaeology of the Frontier in the Medieval Near East (Archaeological Institute of America Monographs)



Excavations that began in 1981 in Gritille, Turkey, were in search of Bronze and Iron Age material but, instead, archaeologists discovered important evidence for the medieval boundary between Islam and Christianity.
