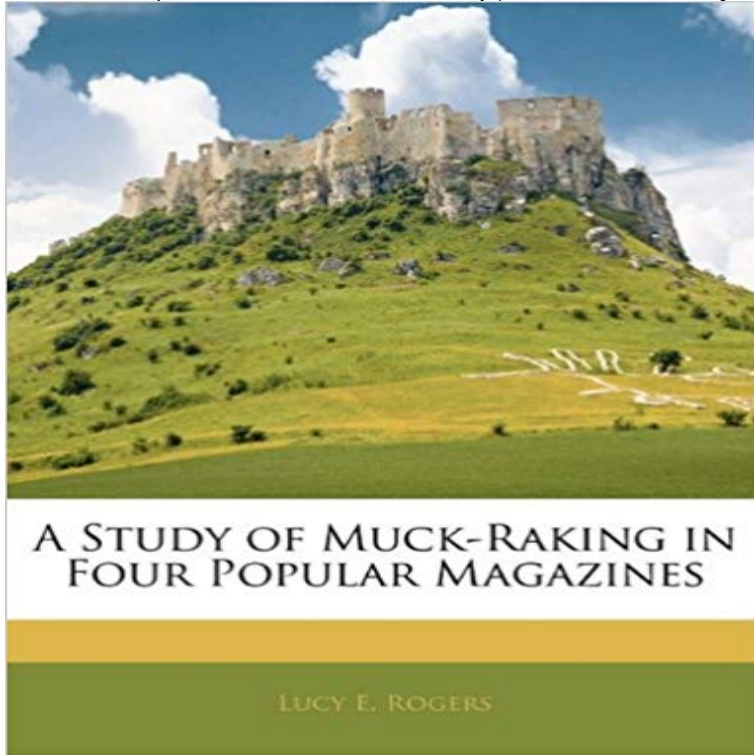


A Study of Muck-Raking in Four Popular Magazines
