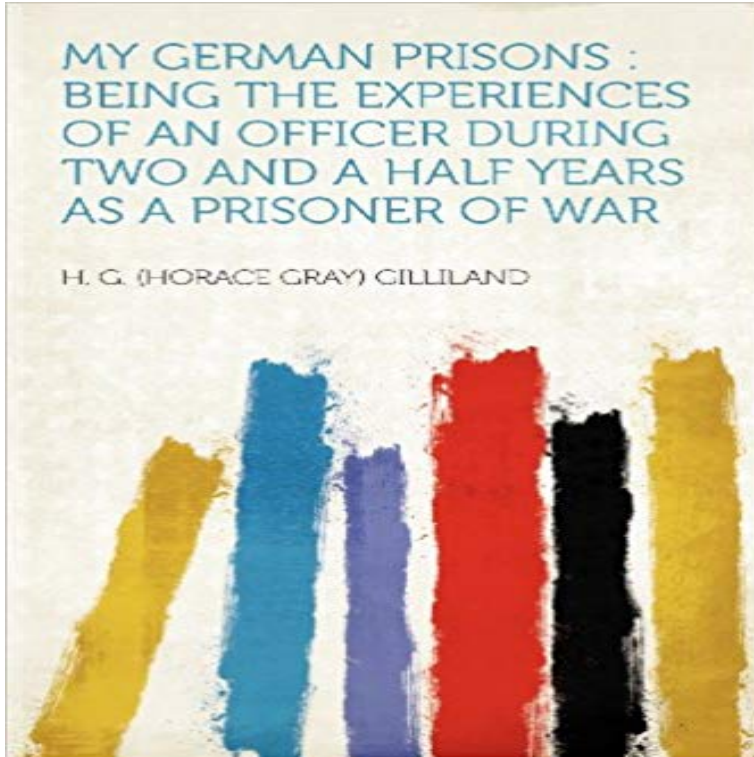


# My German Prisons: Being the Experiences of an Officer During Two and a Half Years as a Prisoner of War
