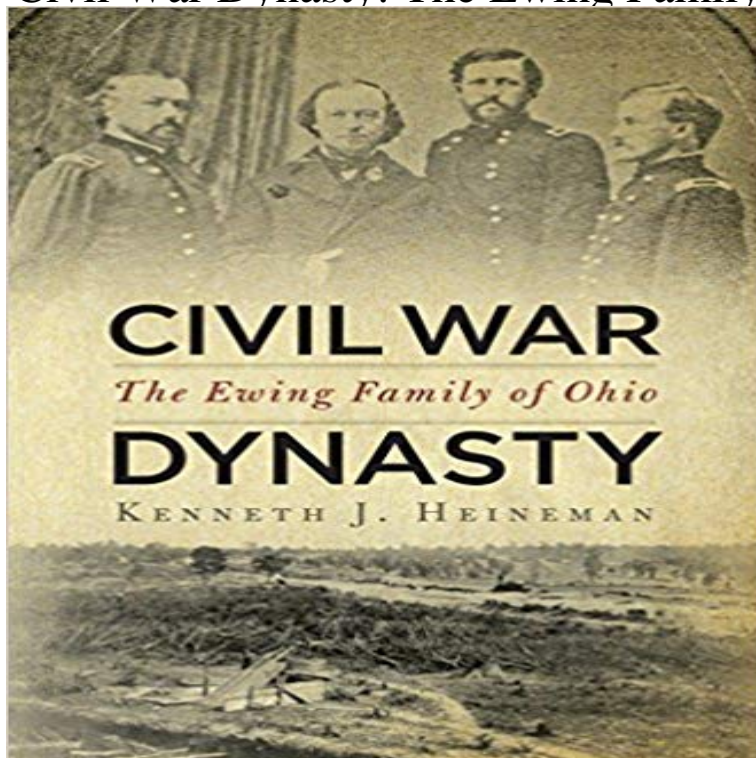


Civil War Dynasty: The Ewing Family of Ohio
