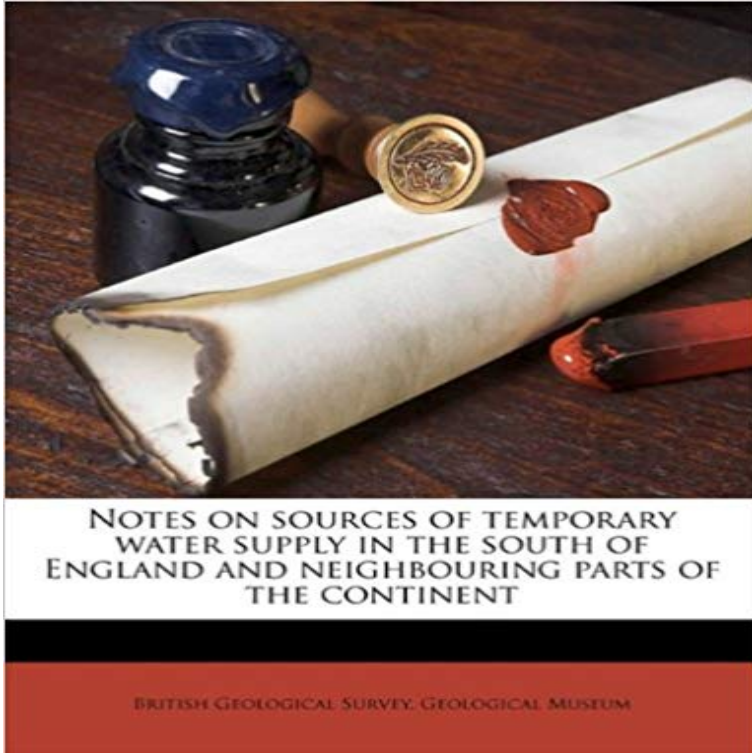


# Notes on sources of temporary water supply in the south of England and neighbouring parts of the continent
