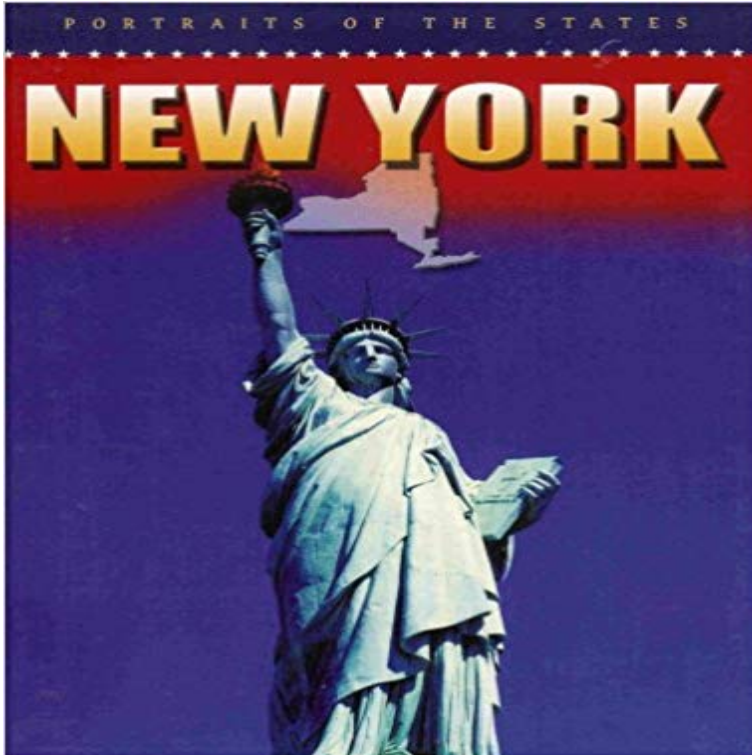


## Portraits of the States Series: New York [Grades 2 and Up]
