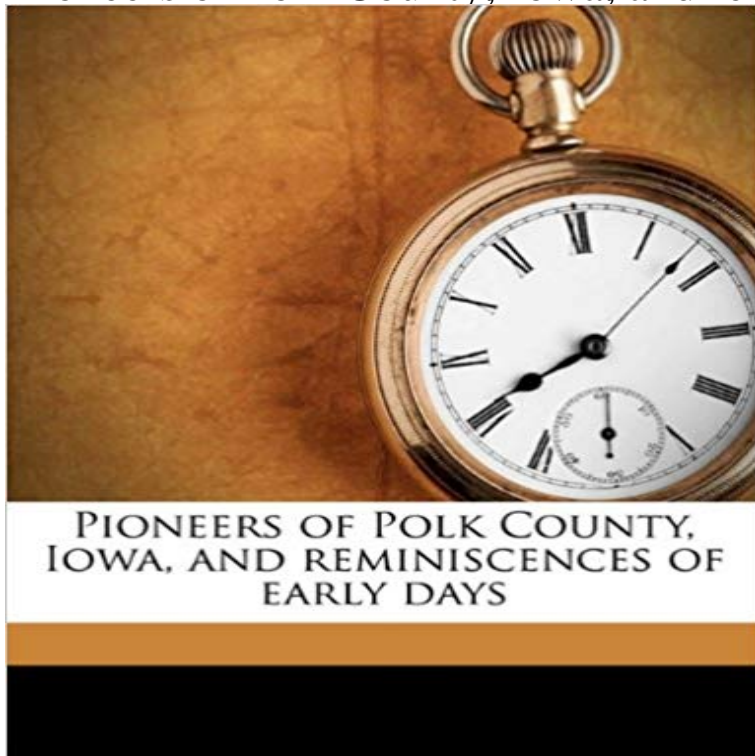


Pioneers of Polk County, Iowa, and reminiscences of early days
