
## **Prehistoric Thessaly**

Chapters I - X, which are purely descriptive, contain full accounts of our own excavations with a summary of the discoveries of others. These we hope will be of permanent value, but how far the theories put forward in the other chapters can be justified time alone can show.Our own excavations in North Greece have all been conducted under the aegis of the British School at Athens, of which we are students. superseded by the present work, and the views expressed in the other papers are to be modified in accordance with Chapters XI - XVII and Appendix I. Mr Droops enforced absence since 1909 has proved an irreparable loss. During our excavations at Lianokladhi and Tsani we were fortunate in having the assistance of Mr T. E. Peet, thanks to the generosity of the British School Athens.As regards transliteration of Ancient Greek we have followed the system recommended by the British School at Athens. According to this all Greek words and names are preserved in the Greek forms, and only those that are in common use are Latinised. It may be thought that we have Latinised too many names, but we think that the ordinary reader will recognise Chaeronea more easily than Chaironeia.
