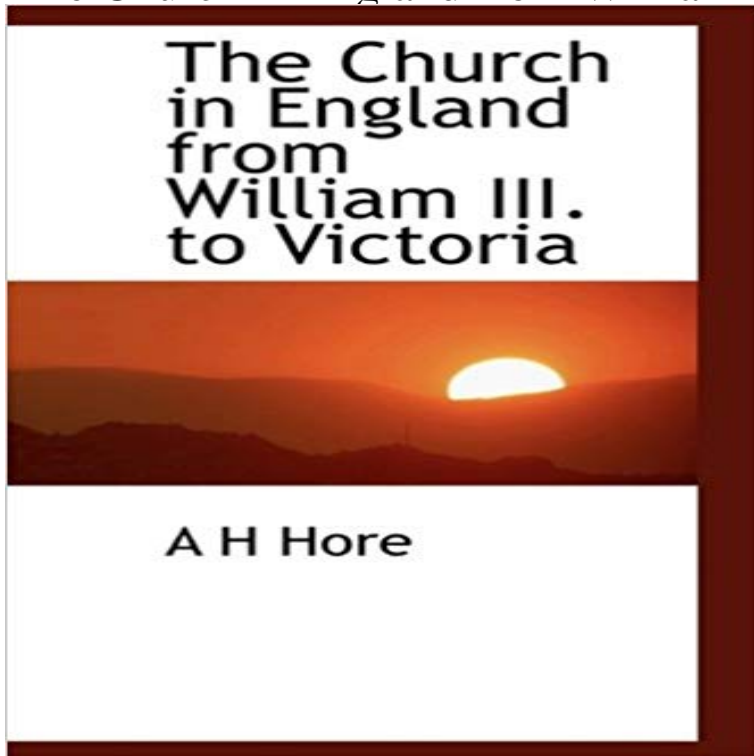


The Church in England from William III. to Victoria
