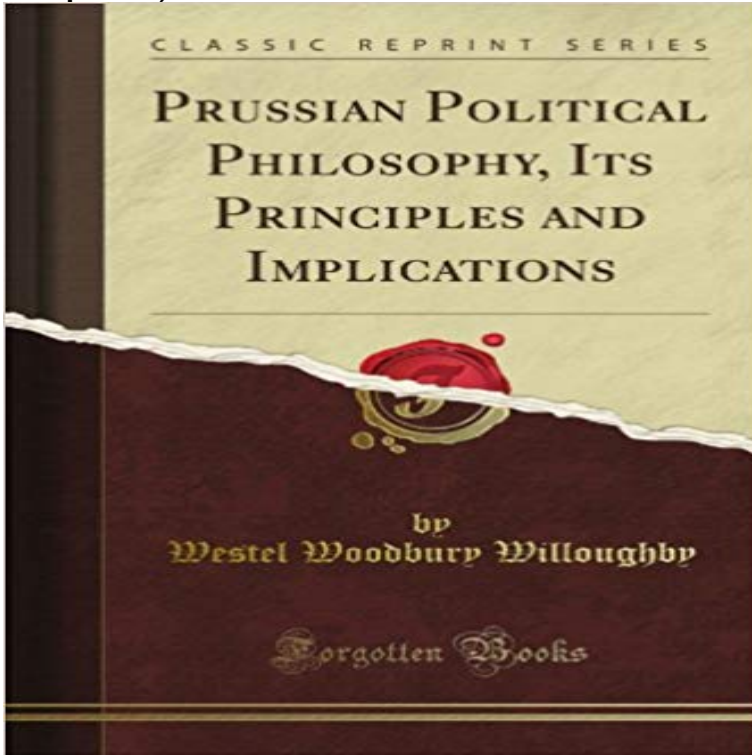


Prussian Political Philosophy, Its Principles and Implications (Classic Reprint)

Upon their intelligent judgment the decision must be founded whether or not the government shall be guided by the highest ideals of justice and humanity, and the actions of its government wisely conceived and efficiently executed.
