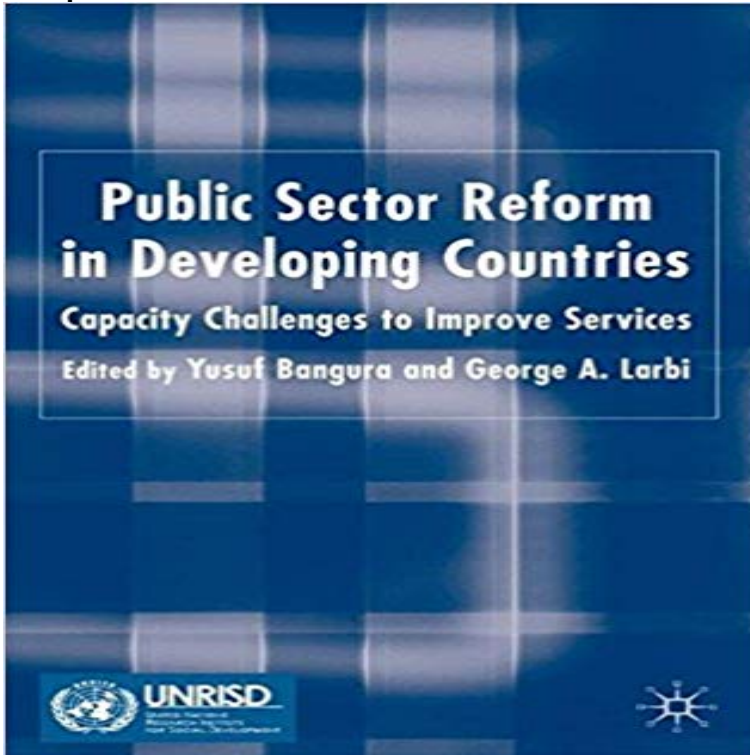


Public Sector Reform in Developing Countries: Capacity Challenges to Improve Services
