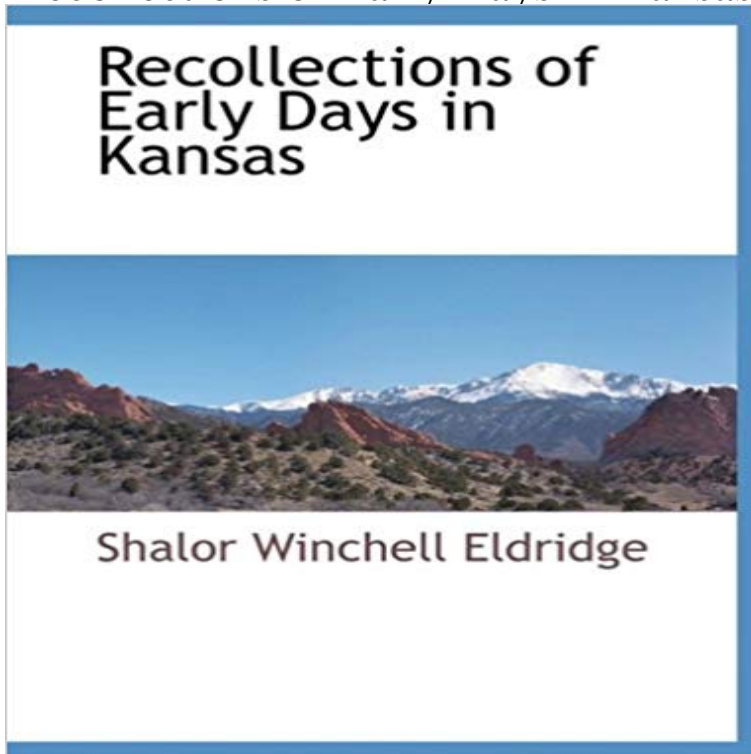


Recollections of Early Days in Kansas
