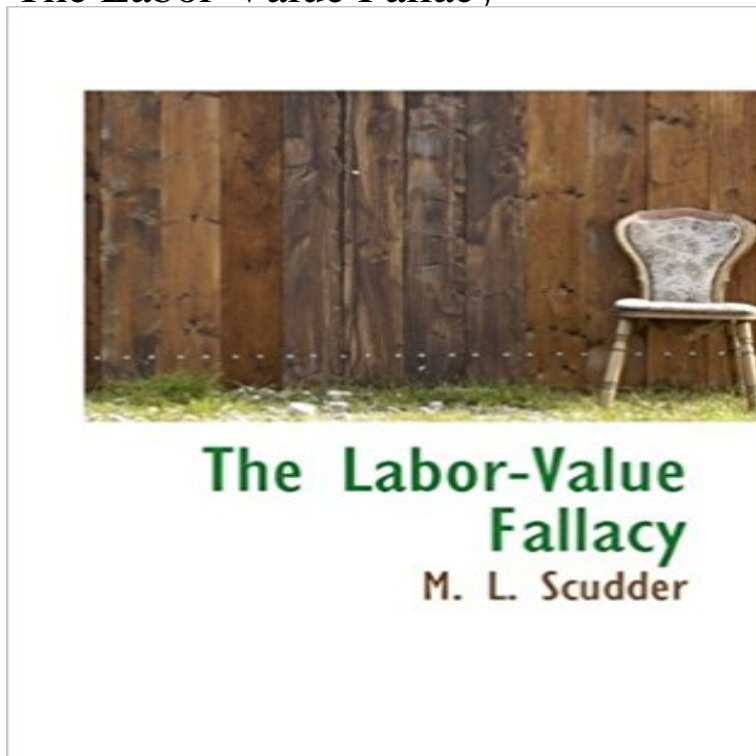


The Labor-Value Fallacy
