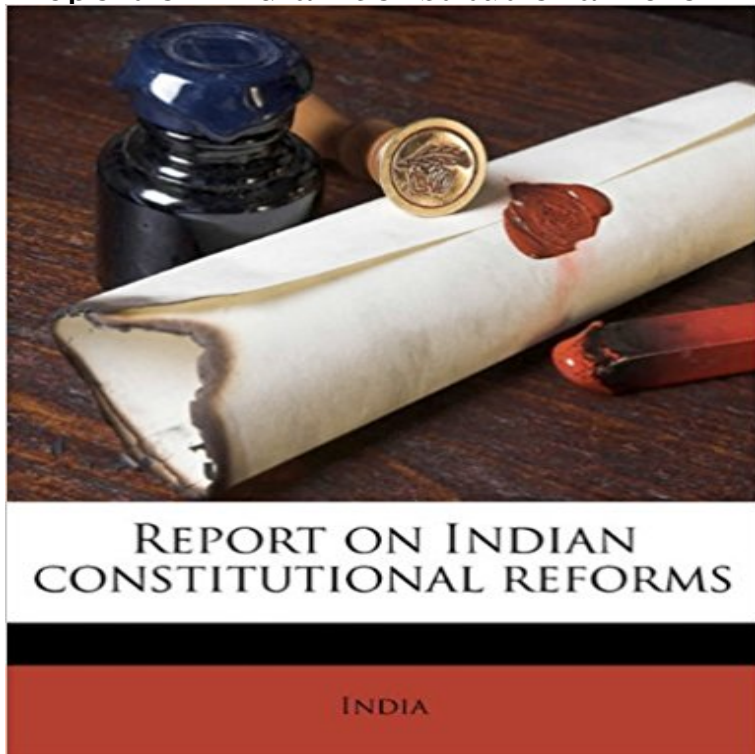


Report on Indian constitutional reforms
