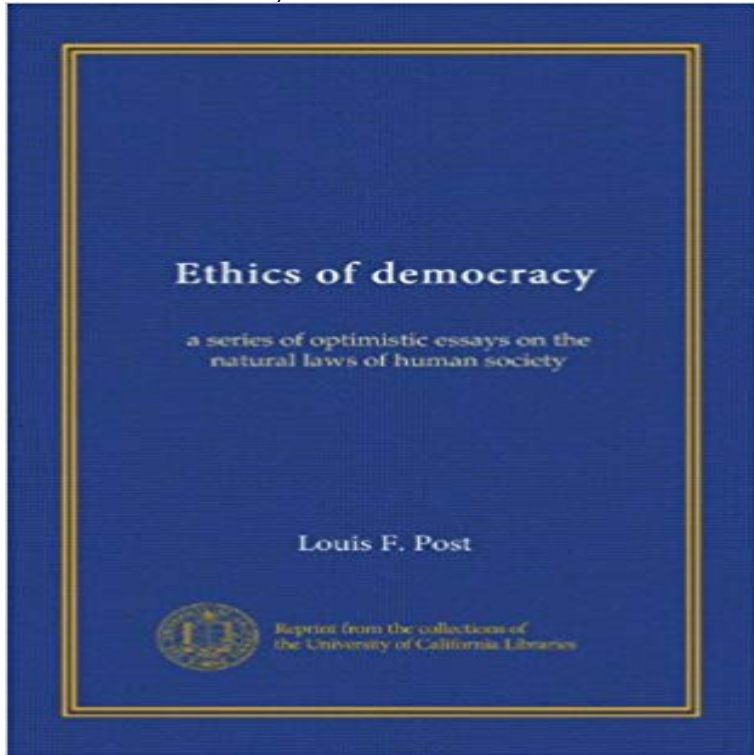


Ethics of democracy: a series of optimistic essays on the natural laws of human society
