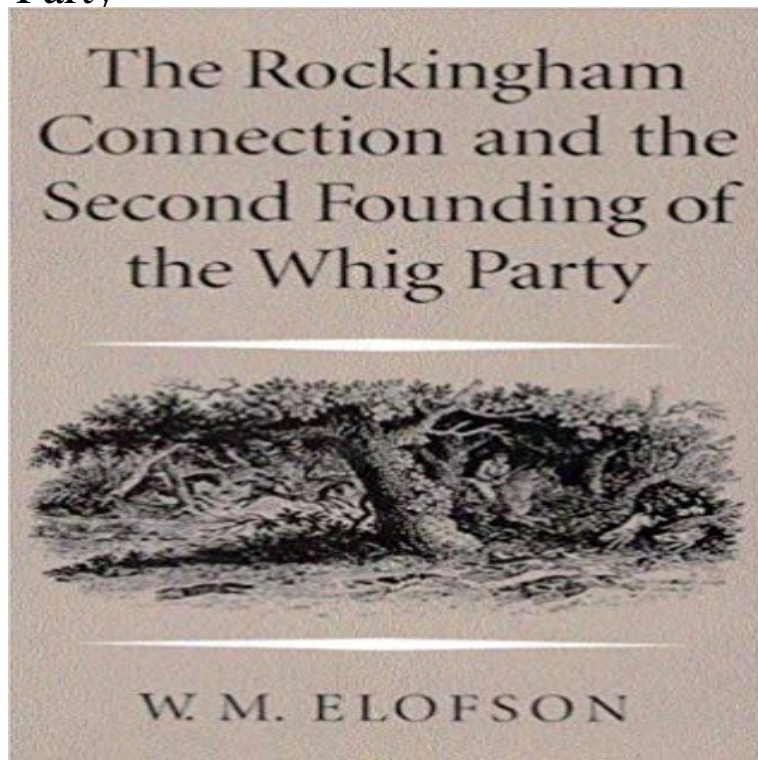


The Rockingham Connection and the Second Founding of the Whig Party
