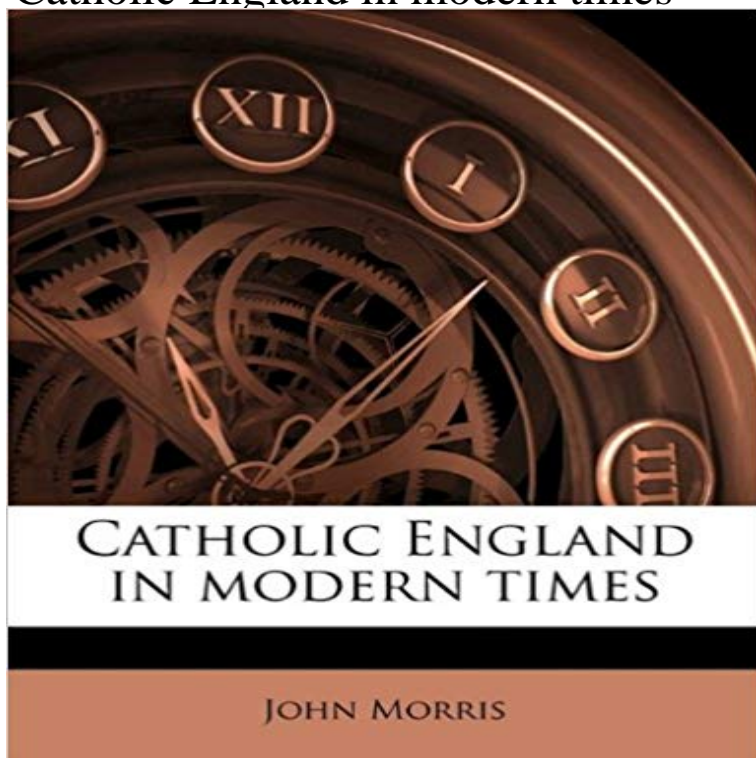


## Catholic England in modern times
