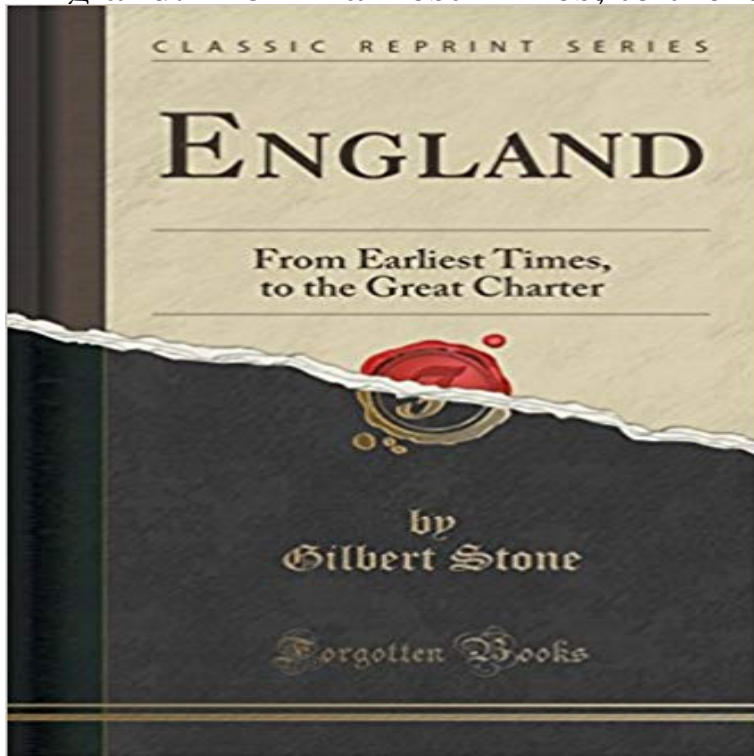

The youth of England was a sturdy and striving one. Progress and retrogression alternate, and the social history of the period is both complex and varied.
