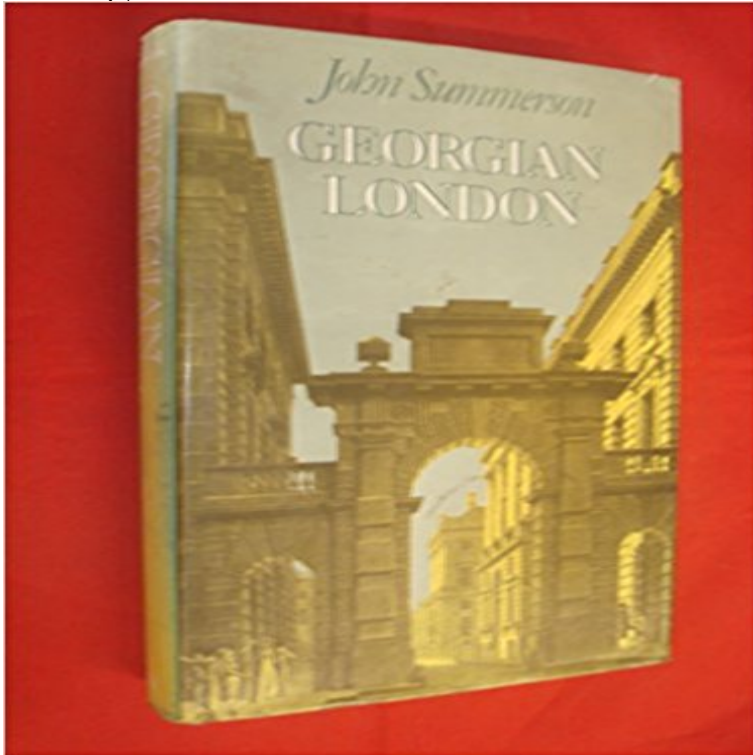


Georgian London
