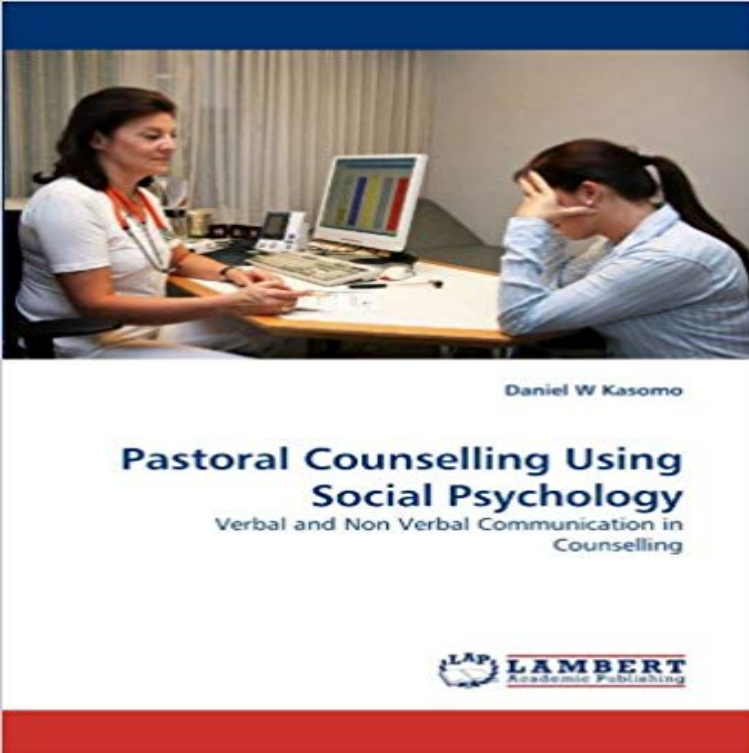


Pastoral Counselling Using Social Psychology: Verbal and Non Verbal Communication in Counselling
