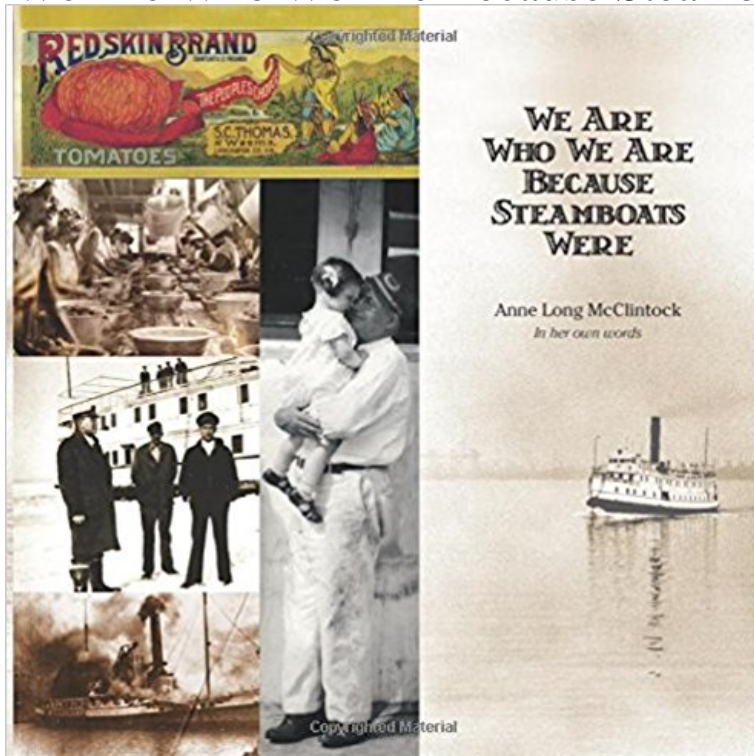


## We Are Who We Are Because Steamboats Were
