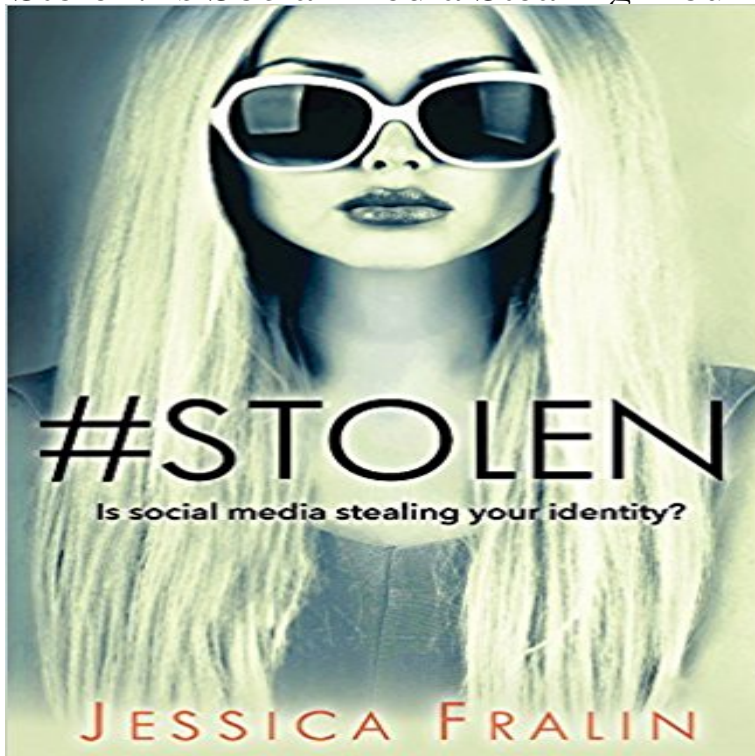


Stolen: Is Social Media Stealing Your Identity?
