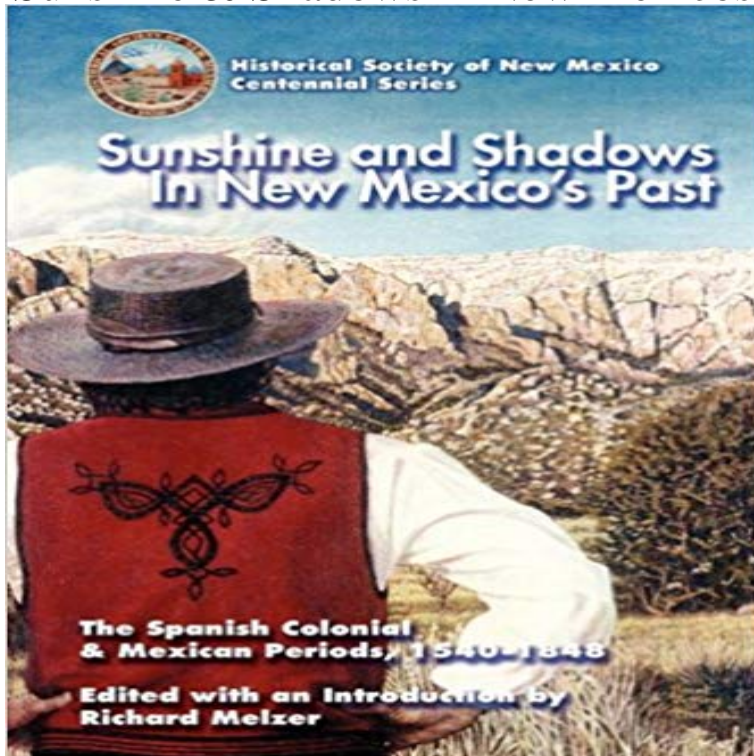


## Sunshine & Shadows in New Mexico's Past
