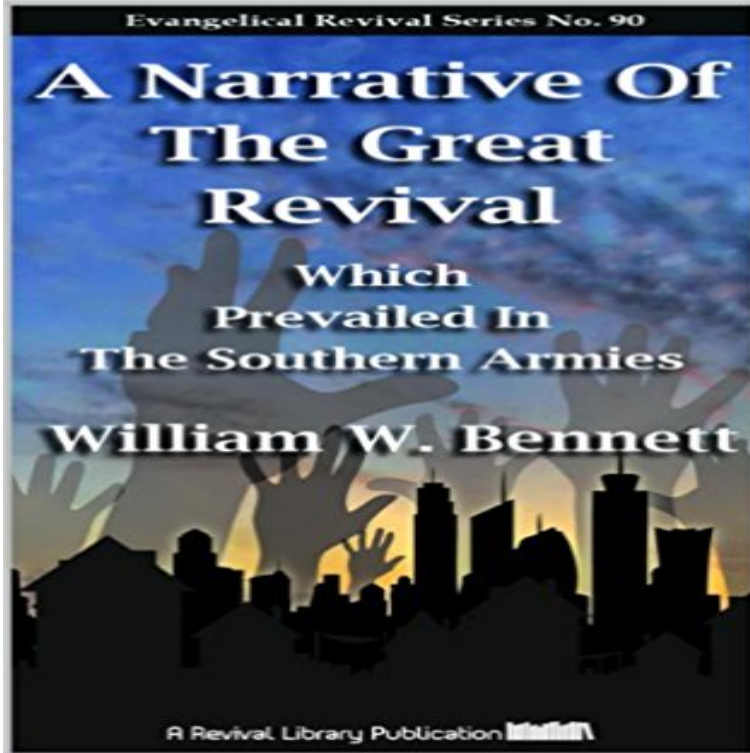


A Narrative Of The Great Revival Which Prevailed In The Southern Armies (Evangelical Revivals Book 90)
