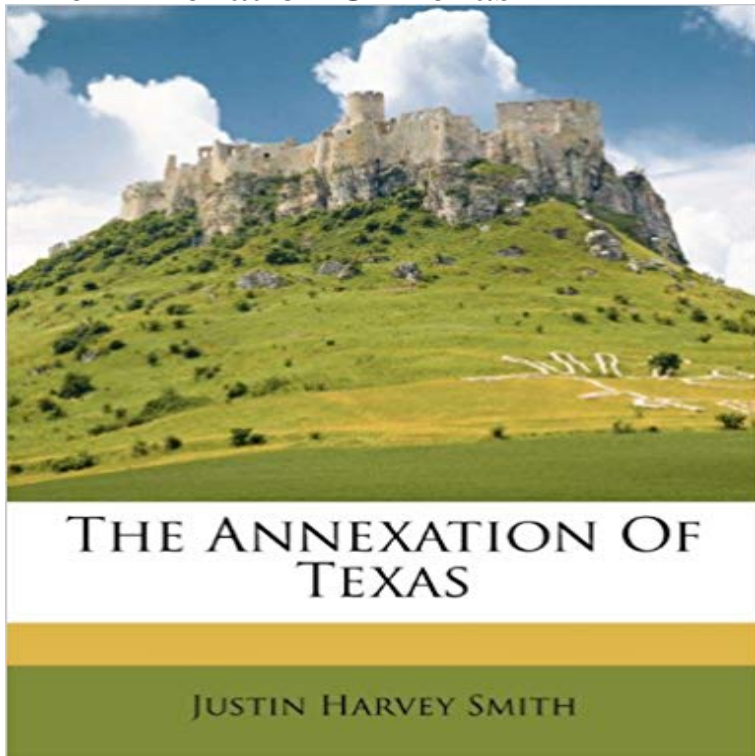


The Annexation Of Texas
