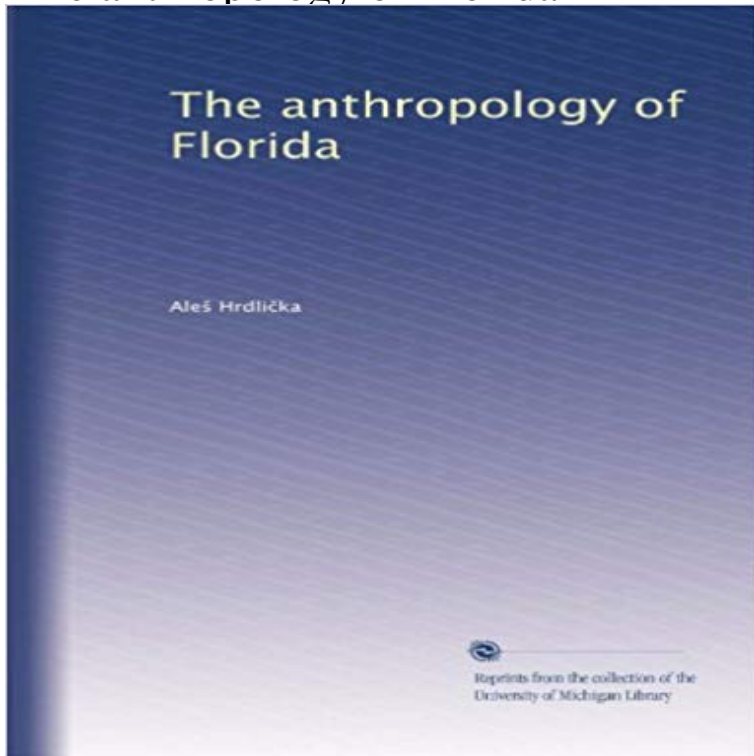


The anthropology of Florida
