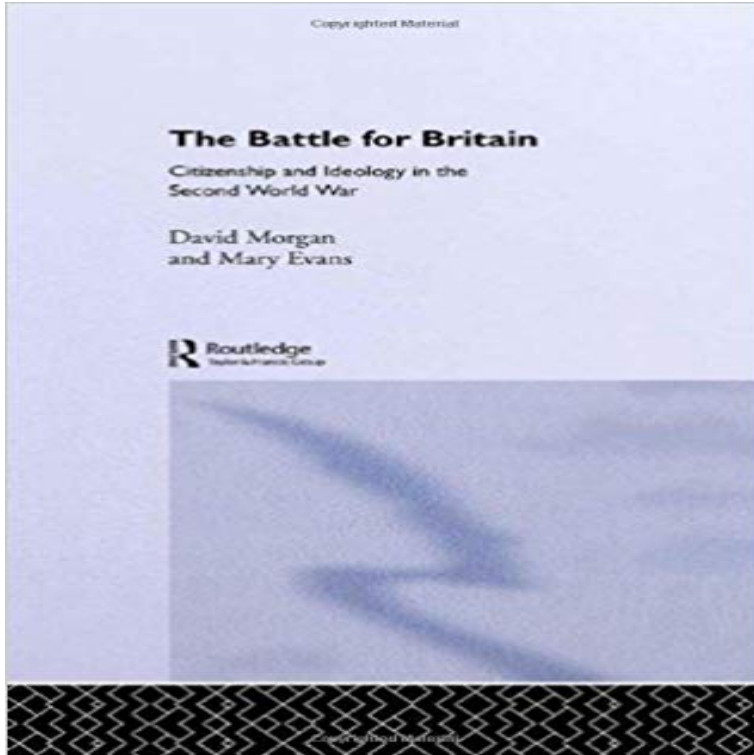


The Battle for Britain: Citizenship and Ideology in the Second World War
