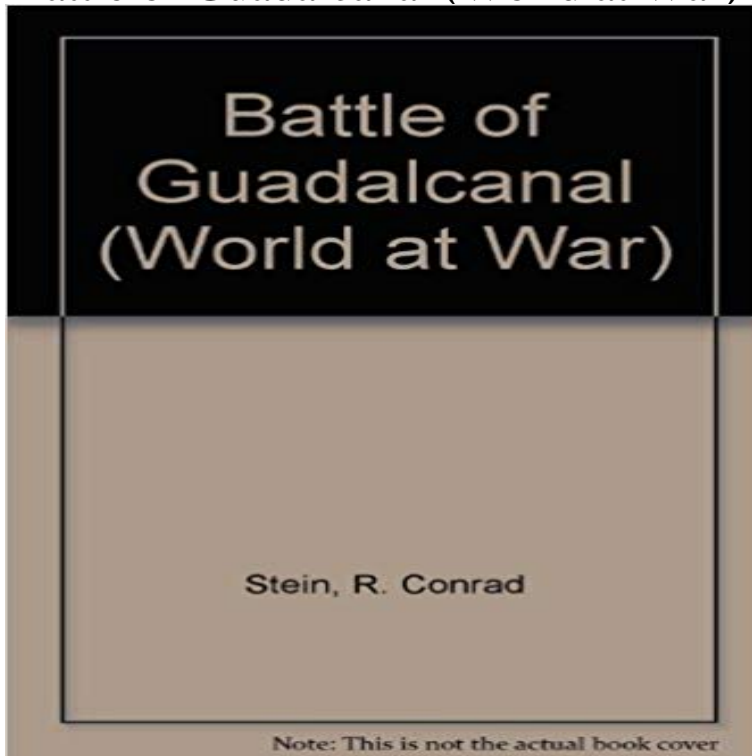


Battle of Guadalcanal (World at War)
