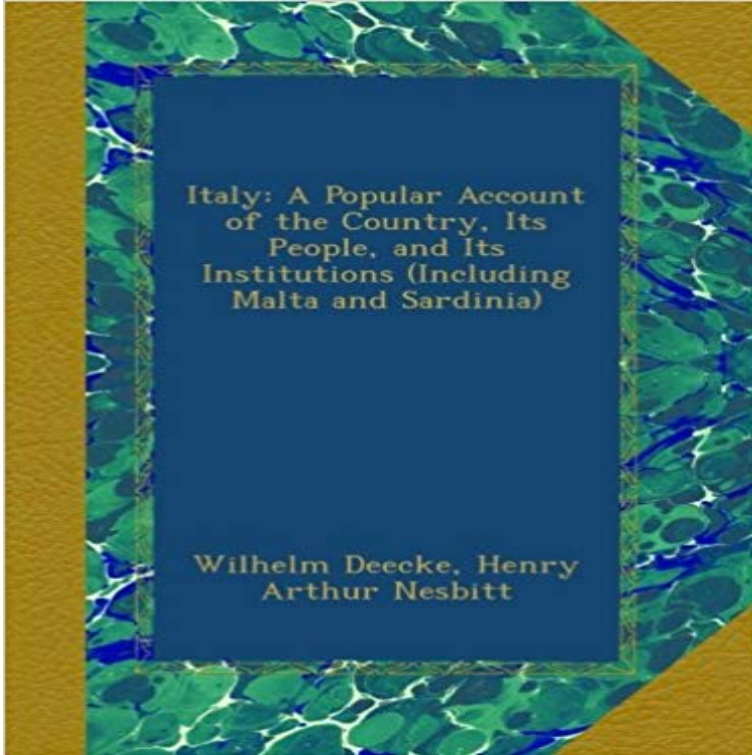


Italy: A Popular Account of the Country, Its People, and Its Institutions (Including Malta and Sardinia)
