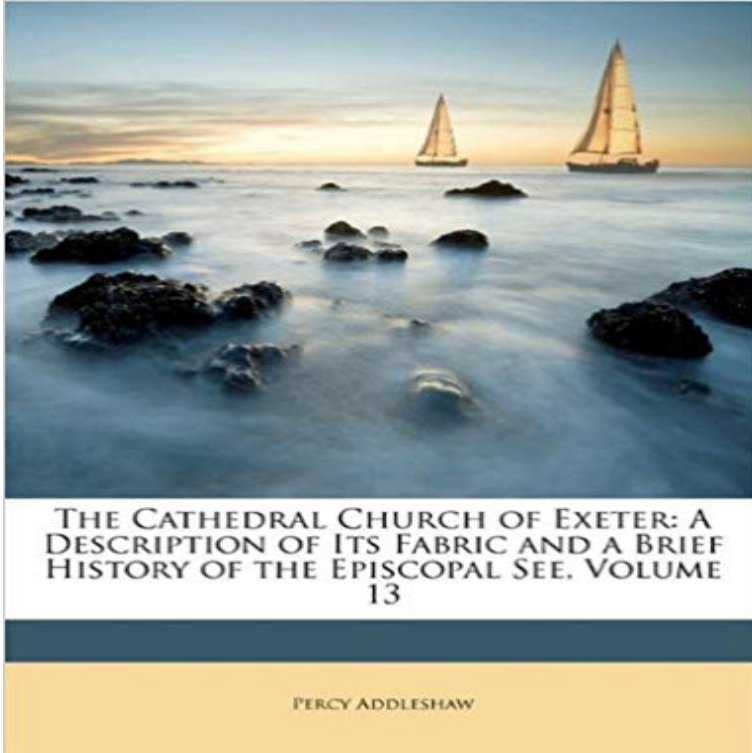


The Cathedral Church of Exeter: A Description of Its Fabric and a Brief History of the Episcopal See, Volume 13
