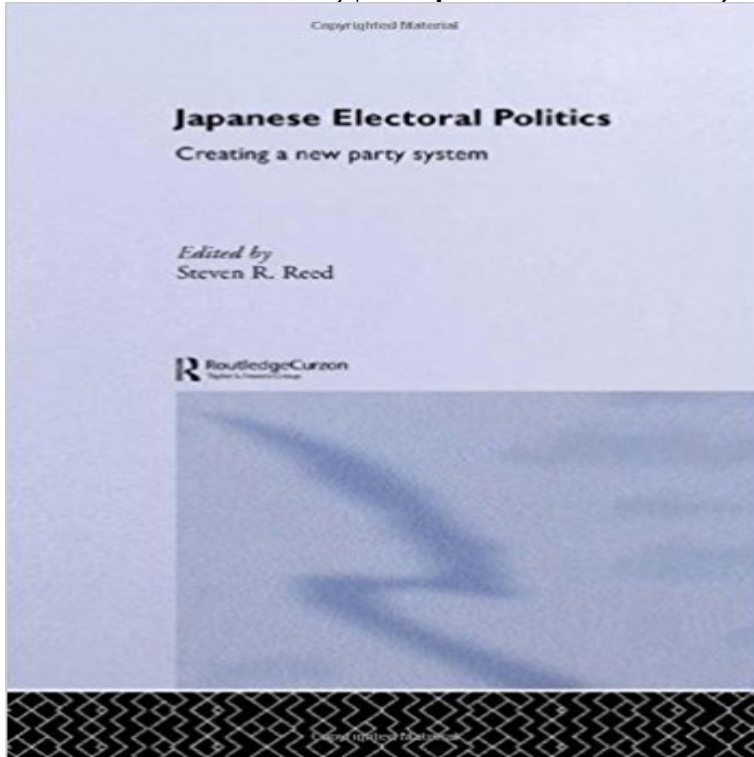


Japanese Electoral Politics: Creating a New Party System (Nissan Institute/Routledge Japanese Studies)
