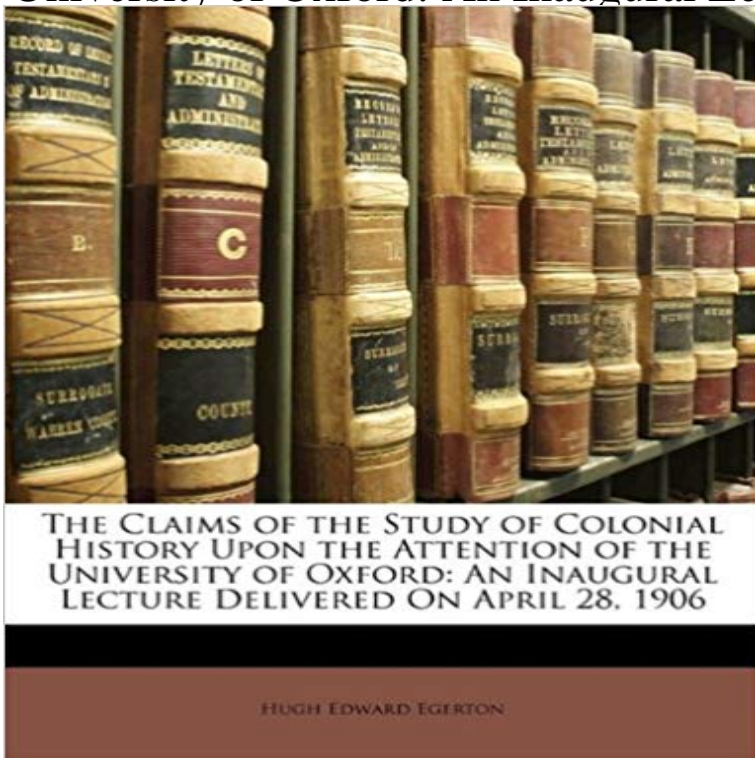


The Claims of the Study of Colonial History Upon the Attention of the University of Oxford: An Inaugural Lecture Delivered On April 28, 1906
