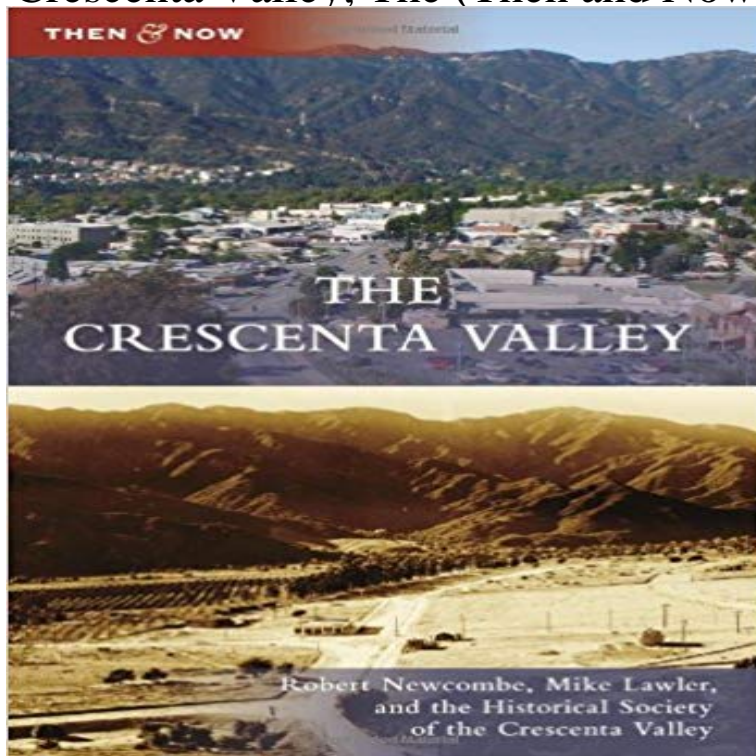


Crescenta Valley, The (Then and Now)
