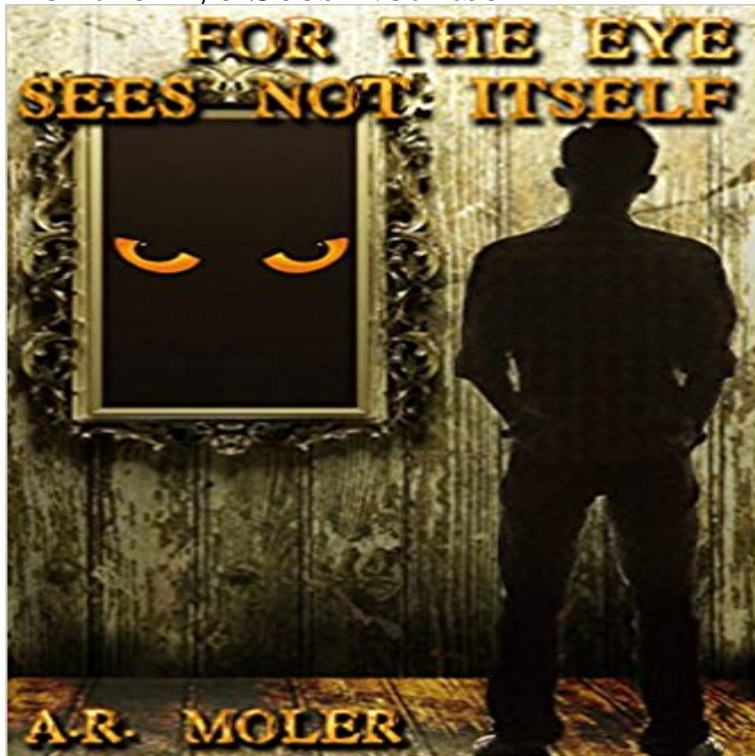


For the Eye Sees Not Itself
