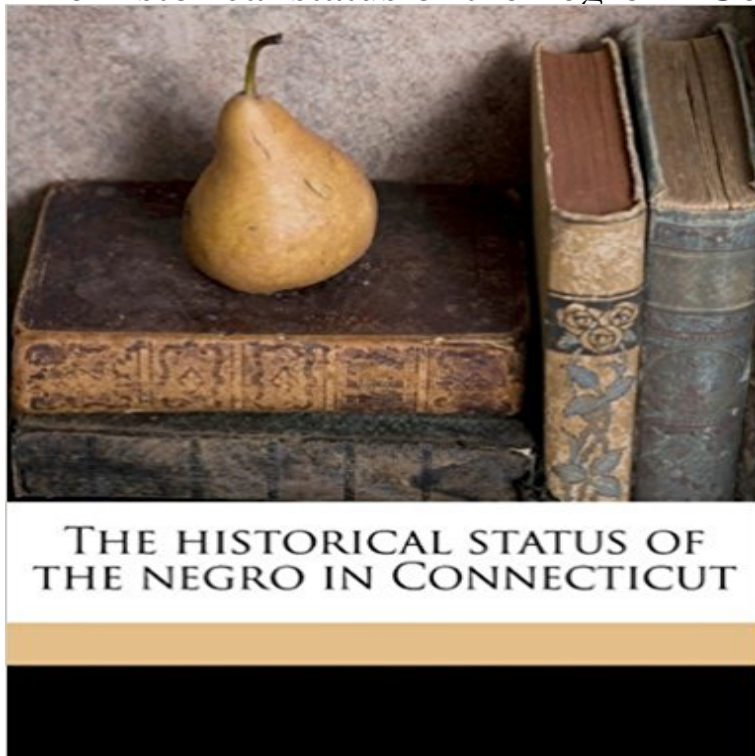


The historical status of the negro in Connecticut
