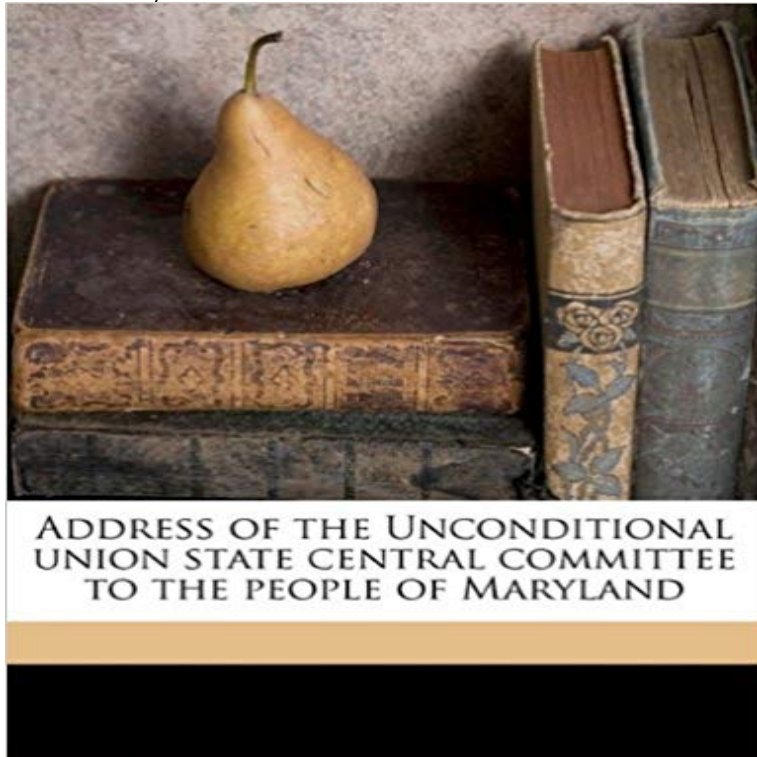


# Address of the Unconditional union state central committee to the people of Maryland
