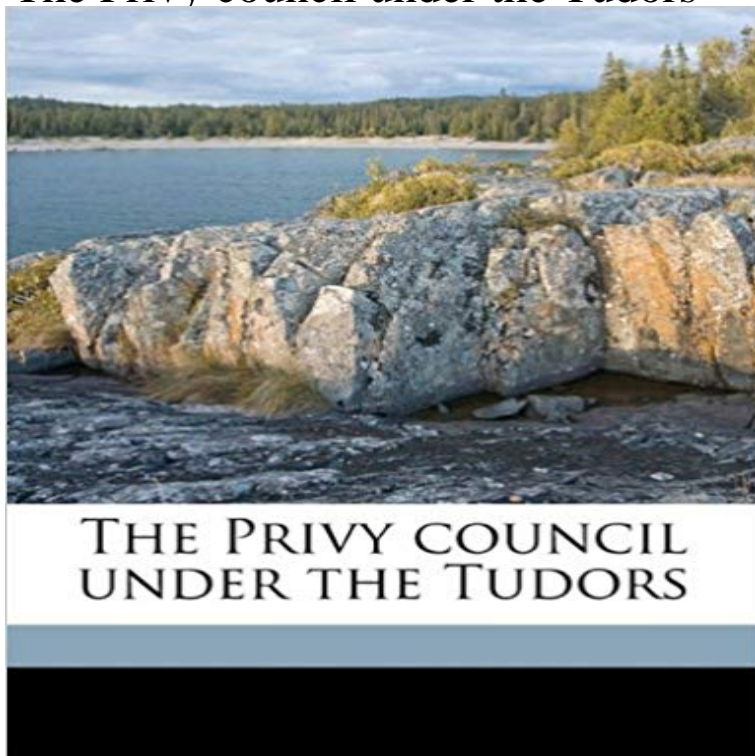


The Privy council under the Tudors
