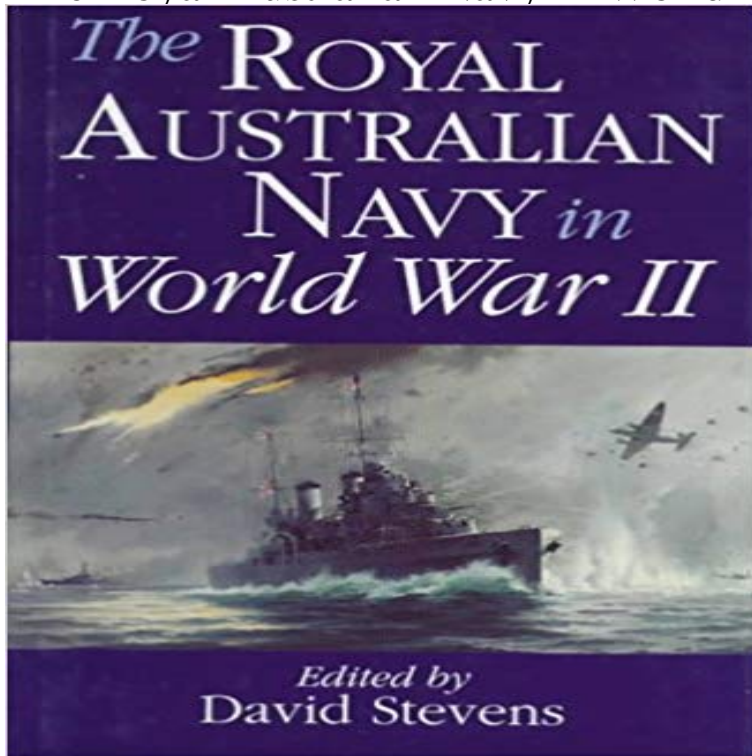


## The Royal Australian Navy in World War II
