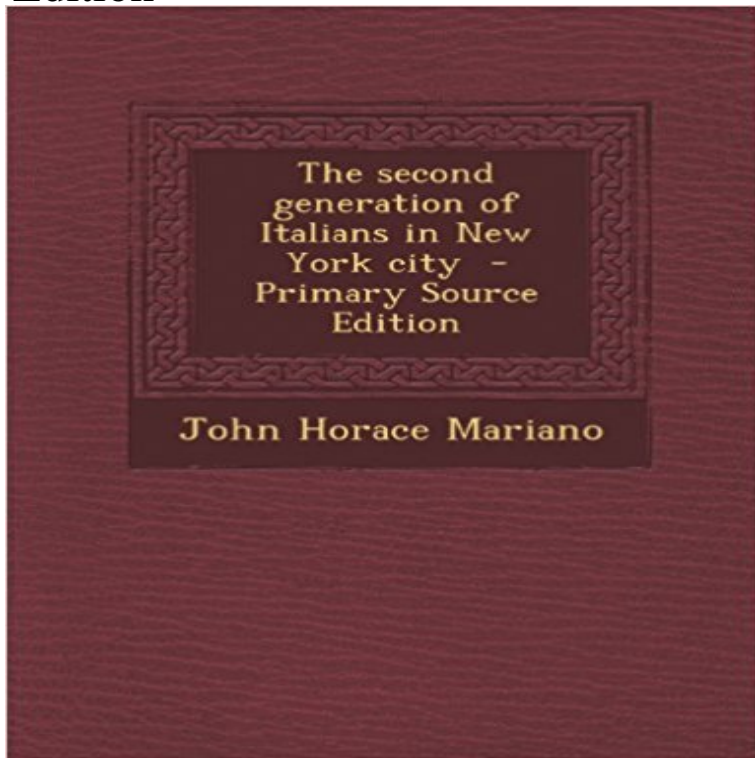


The Second Generation of Italians in New York City - Primary Source Edition
