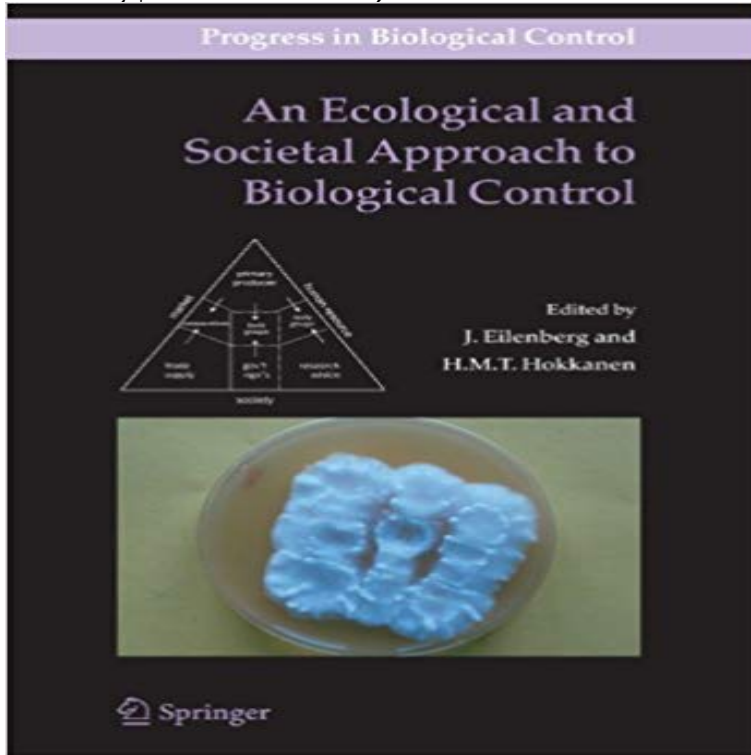


An Ecological and Societal Approach to Biological Control (Progress in Biological Control)
